

2016 Guangdong Qingyuan Winter Camp Expectations and Rules

Students are expected

- Be the best representative of New Zealand at all times
- Respect the wishes of the accompanying teacher and the others on the camp
- Take every opportunities to experience the culture and practice Chinese language
- Be helpful to Chinese students who wish to improve their English
- Be good cultural ambassadors
- Participate fully in all activities organised by the host
- Play a role as a member of the team with a positive attitude
- Prepare a NZ song or cultural item to share
- Keep a diary record of experience including photo taken
- Prepare a report on their return for presentation at a school assembly or funding organisations
- Send a thank you letter to the organiser on return if required

Performance

It is strongly advised that students prepare an item to perform, should an occasion arise to do so.

Attendance

All students are expected to attend the scheduled programme, cooperating with and showing respect to staff and hosts. Be punctual for all the activities and wear appropriate clothes.

Accommodation

Students will be accommodated with clear house rules, being given separate rooms with a code of respectful behaviour towards each other, staff and premises. Students must abide by the lights out time and checks will be made to ensure that students return to their allocated rooms on time.

Outings

The camp is in the closed management. Students are to adhere to the programme as outlined. Any additional outings must be approved by the leading staff. No student is to leave the camp premises or the group without permission.

Misbehaviour

Students must not participate in any sexual contact or activities, not to possess or use any pornographic materials such as magazine, videos, or internet sites. The use, purchase or possession of alcoholic drinks, tobacco products, or illegal drugs is prohibited.

Camp senior management will be immediately notified of any serious breach of rules and may result in stand down from camp on return to NZ. Where a student's behaviour is deemed to jeopardize the safe or successful continuation of the camp, that student may be sent home to NZ at the family's expense. In such cases, the parents will have been advised of any deterioration in behaviour in advance, where this is practicable.

Communication

All participants must have a cell phone on the tour for communication and emergency contacts.

Passport must have an expiry date after 30 July 2017. In the event of a lost passport, visa or wallet, costs will be met in the interim by the tour leader. Any such costs must be repaid in full by the family of the student(s) in question within 7 days of a return to NZ

Please note: Once the student is accepted for the summer camp, a deposit of \$500 into the Christchurch Guangdong Association Inc. ASB bank account is required by 15th of August 2016, which is non-refundable so that all the air tickets can be booked with a fixed number of participants.
